How to Prevent Wasps, Hornets, and Yellow Jackets from Invading Your Yard or Home



The following are steps you can take to help keep wasps and hornets away from your home:

- Clean outdoor trash cans frequently and always keep the lids on tight
- Keep leaves and yard debris swept up and orderly
- Keep bushes and trees properly pruned
- Empty standing water from bird baths, rain gutters, animal dishes, and other items that collect rain water
- Spray any newly formed nests with a pyrethroid wasp spray, such as [PT Wasp Freeze II Aerosol](#), then knock the nest down
