4. Watering Can, Garden Hose, and Attachments



Keep your plants hydrated with a [garden hose](#) (or watering can if your garden is small). There are many [sprayer wands](#), [nozzles](#), and [attachments](#) available including wand attachments, that will make watering and reaching tall plants like tomatoes easier. Remember to water in the morning to avoid burning flower and vegetable leaves in the hot sun, and to allow time for the plants to absorb the water.
