Pests can be a nuisance outdoors, but once they get inside your home, they can multiply into an infestation. Some pests prefer to stay outside while others will search out shelters like homes and buildings to protect themselves from the elements, especially during cold weather.

PEST **1** Ants



[Ants](#) will enter homes in search of food and water. If food is found, they will bring it back to their colony, which may be outside of the home. While [getting rid of what attracts ants](#) is crucial to eliminating an infestation, a perimeter pest control treatment can help prevent ants from entering your home. Depending on the preventative [ant spray](#) you select, you will need to re-apply the barrier around your home every 30 to 90 days to maintain protection.

PEST **2** Cockroaches



Like ants, [roaches](#) will search out food and water sources in homes and businesses, and will also look for hiding spots in which to lay their eggs. In addition to applying a perimeter pest control spray every 30 to 90 days, getting rid of food and water sources and eliminating roach entry points are just some of the steps needed to [keep cockroaches out of your home](#).

PEST **3** Silverfish



[Silverfish](#) can eat fabrics, books, photos, and even wallpaper. [Keeping silverfish out of your home](#) by controlling moisture and treating with a perimeter insecticide spray can save your possessions and preserve your memories.

PEST **4** Stink Bugs



Known for the smell they emit, [stink bugs](#) are a type of overwintering pest that tries to enter homes, office buildings, and other structures during the late fall to stay warm in the winter. It's only when temperatures warm in the spring and the pests try to return outdoors that their infestations are evident. Applying a perimeter treatment to prevent stink bugs from entering in the first place is the best way to [avoid an overwintering pest infestation](#).

PEST **5** Asian Lady Beetles



[Asian lady beetles](#), along with [boxelder beetles](#) and [cluster flies](#), are also overwintering pests that seeks out shelter in homes and business as the temperatures begin to drop in the fall. These invasive beetles can be especially bothersome when large groups enter your home or emerge in the spring warmth to return outdoors and find food. [Treating the perimeter of your home](#) with an insecticide spray before the first frost can help keep Asian Lady Beetles out in the cold.
