DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that

will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through spray drift. Do not use indoors. All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only. Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any areas like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow product to enter any drain during or after application. Do not water treated area to the point of run-off. Do not make applications during rain.

[This product is non-staining to most home siding and asphalt shingles depending on the condition and cleanliness. However, you should test it in an inconspicuous area for compatibility before using on these surfaces.]

TO KILL WASPS, HORNETS, BEES AND YELLOW JACKETS

1. Apply early morning or late evening when the most insects are on the nest.
2. Spray from a safe distance with the wind at your back to avoid spray drift. Do not stand directly under the nest.
3. Shake can well before use. Aim nozzle at the nest and push button to spray.
4. Soak the nest with the spray contacting as many insects as possible.
5. Wait 24 hours before removing nest so returning insects will be killed.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Causes moderate eye irritation. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.
