

Bengal Foaming Wasp & Hornet Killer should be used outdoors on Wasp, Bee and Hornet nests.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TO KILL WASPS, HORNETS, BEES AND YELLOW JACKETS

- Do not stand directly under the nest.
- Shake can well before use. Aim nozzle at the nest and push button to spray.
 Soak the nest with the spray contacting as many insects as possible.

FIRST AID
