Features and Benefits

Black Carpet Beetle kits feature Insect Limited's signature pheromone Bullet Lures™ that attract Black Carpet Beetle adult males with a controlled release of pheromone over a 3-month period. The lures are paired with the Flat Trap™ which is the recommended, field-tested and best trapping system for these beetles. These traps can easily be placed on floors, under furniture or on shelves in closets or throughout other living spaces or storage rooms. Beetles that are attracted to the lure are readily stuck in the glue upon entering the trap.

Problem Solved

This Black Carpet Beetle Kit pairs the science of insect biology to the technology of a trapping system to assist you with the task of monitoring for these pests in your environment. In an Integrated Pest Management program, monitoring can ultimately help you reduce pest numbers. When paired with a trapping system, the kits do this by:

- 1. Telling you if the beetles are present
- 2. Indicating where they are coming from
- 3. Finally telling you whether the control measures that you have taken are working or not

What to Expect

When you open this kit box, you will find the traps unfolded, and stacked along with individually packaged Bullet Lures and an Instruction Sheet of:

- How to place the lure into the trap
- Where to place the traps
- When to replace the traps

The traps will need to be folded into place by hand, according to the instructions on the back of the kit box. The glue pad on each trap is covered with release paper that should be removed after the traps have been folded into place.

When you open this box, you will find 10 pheromone Bullet Lures™. Each pheromone lure is individually packaged to keep them fresh until you are ready to place them into a trap.

When you are ready to use this product, the lures should be removed from their packaging by cutting or tearing the plastic package. The lures should then be placed on their sides into the center of the glue surface of sticky traps.

Although the pheromone in the Bullet Lures[™] is non-toxic, avoid direct contact with your skin if possible or simply wash your hands with warm water and soap if contact is made. Pheromone Bullet Lures[™] are non-pesticidal and only act as a moth attractant.

The traps are then ready to be placed out in areas where beetles are being seen. These traps will begin your monitoring program for Black Carpet Beetles that are attracted to the pheromones in the Bullet Lure. These traps will give you the information that you need to reduce or remove your Black Carpet Beetle issue.
