Bonide's Bone Meal is especially formulated for bulbs, peonies, ivy, iris and ferns. It promotes root and stem growth and continues to feed over a long period of time.

How to read a fertilizer label.

Fertilizers are rated by three numbers, such as 6-12-10. The numbers tell what percentage of primary nutrients the fertilizer contains. The first number is the percentage of Nitrogen; the second number is the percentage Available Phosphate (P₂O₅); the third number is the percentage of soluble Potash (K₂O).

When purchasing fertilizer, keep in mind that typically the first number, or Nitrogen, emphasizes a green color and denser foliage. The middle number, Available Phosphate, emphasizes the development of flowers, fruits or vegetables. And the third number, Soluble Potash, emphasizes overall plant hardiness and its ability to withstand stress.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply Only as Directed. Wash off any plant food which accidentally gets on foliage.

For best results, apply Bone Meal twice each year. Apply once early in the Spring after the last frost and again in the Fall.

Bed Plantings: Thoroughly work about 3 lbs. of Bonide Bone Meal into each 50 sq. ft. of bed area.

Roses: Apply 1/4 pound (1cup) per mature bush. Work lightly into top 1 to 2 inches of soil. Do not disturb roots. Water thoroughly.

Bulbs: Apply 1/2 to 2 teaspoons per bulb depending on size. Place in soil 2" below bulb.
