FOR BEST RESULTS

1. Best results are obtained when rainfall occurs within two weeks following application.
2. Optimal weed control is achieved when Bromacil 80 is applied as a pre-emergent, prior to germination.
3. For post-emergent control of perennial species, Bromacil 80 should be tank-mixed with a systemic, foliar-absorbed herbicide, such as glyphosate.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fill the tank 1/4 to 1/3 full of water.
2. While agitating, add the required amount of Bromacil 80.
3. Continue agitation until the herbicide is fully dispersed.
4. Maintain agitation and continue filling the tank with water.
5. Add any tank mix partners, if desired, followed by the necessary volume of spray adjuvant.
