

## HOW TO USE CITRUSGAIN: CITRUSGAIN is formulated specifically for citrus and other plants having similar requirements.

<b>When to Apply</b>	Feed every 4-6 weeks throughout the growing season. In areas where there is a threat of frost, feed every 4-6 weeks from February to September.	Feed twice per season: 1st application when new growth begins, 2nd application 6-8 weeks later.			Feed every 10-12 weeks.	

Water trees the **day before** fertilizer application. Apply CITRUSGAIN evenly over the soil surface, within the drip line of the plant but away from the trunk. Do **not** apply fertilizer against the trunk of the trees or at the base of the plant stems. Be sure to water the area well after fertilizing. Take care to brush or wash fertilizer granules off leaves to prevent injury (burn).
