

## How to Use Your Drain Fly Kit

This document is meant as a general guide to our customers and is not meant as a replacement for reading product labels. Always read the label of each product before use!

### Drain Fly Kit Contents

Our Drain Fly Kit is an easy and effective way to control drain flies in your home. This kit includes the products you will need to treat a drain fly infestation and prevent a new infestation from forming. Read below for a step-by-step guide to using your kit.

#### Your kit includes:



1 17 ounce can of [CB-80 Aerosol](#)

2 bottles of [InVade Bio Drain Gel](#)

1 pack of 4 [Catchmaster 100i Insect Monitors](#) sheets (or 12 monitors total), also known as glue board traps.

### STEP 1 Use Monitors to Find Infestation

Before you treat with InVade Bio Drain Gel, you will need to know which drain(s) the flies are emerging from. If you only have one drain in your kitchen or bathroom and have seen flies near or in that drain, you can proceed to Step 2. If you have multiple drains in your kitchen or bathroom, begin with this test.

At night, when the sink, tub, or shower is not in use, place a Catchmaster 100i Insect Monitor over each drain. Fold each board and peel off the plastic from the inside of the monitor. Place a board over each drain, sticky-side down, leaving room on the sides for air to circulate. You do not want the monitor to be flush with the bottom of the sink, tub, or shower as it might stick. Instead, the monitor should resemble a pitched tent over the drain.

In the morning, turn each monitor over and examine for flies. Were there flies on all monitors or just one? You will only treat the drain(s) where flies have been spotted. Using a black marker or pen, circle the flies that were caught on night one.

## STEP 2 Treat with InVade Bio Drain Gel

At night, when the sink, tub, or shower is not in use, pour 4 ounces of InVade Bio Drain Gel down each infested drain. Be sure to coat the sides of the drain when you pour. InVade Bio Drain Gel will break down organic matter in the drain pipe, which is where drain flies breed.



**DO NOT** rinse the drain with water immediately after the gel has been poured. If your drain has a garbage disposal, run the disposal for 1-2 seconds (without running water) to spread the product around the blades of the disposal.

Cover the drain with your Catchmaster 100i Insect Monitor.

In the morning, examine your insect monitor and make note of any new flies that have been caught. Circle these flies with a black marker or pen.

Repeat Step 2 at least 5-7 nights in a row. Make note each morning of how many flies, if any, have been caught the night prior. You should see a reduction in flies as the treatment continues.

You can use the treated sinks, tubs, or showers during the day as usual.

If you have a severe infestation or lots of organic matter in your drains, a second week of treatment may be needed.

## STEP 3 Use the Aerosol Spray to Kill Flies

At any time during the drain fly treatment process, you can use the CB-80 aerosol spray to knockdown active drain flies.

Remove pets and children from the room where drain flies have been spotted. Close doors and windows in the room, remove all food and utensils, then spray. Hold the nozzle of the aerosol can for 2-3 seconds and spray in the middle of a small room. If the room is larger than 1,000 cubic feet, spray 2-3 seconds per 1,000 cubic feet in a sweeping motion around the room. After spraying, leave the room.



Allow the spray to settle and dry before re-entering the room and opening doors and windows. Sweep up and dispose of any fallen insects. Repeat as necessary.

## STEP 4 Treat Drains Monthly

After your infestation has cleared, you can treat your drains once per month with InVade Bio Drain Gel to prevent a re-infestation. Simply pour 4 ounces of InVade Bio Drain Gel down each drain at night when the sink, tub, or shower is no longer in use. Use the sink, tub, or shower as usual for the rest of the month.

If you have 3 or more drains that are infested, you will need to purchase an additional [drain fly kit](#) or an additional bottle of [InVade Bio Drain](#) per drain in order to have enough product for the treatment. 1 bottle of InVade Bio Drain Gel will treat 1 drain for 1 week.
