




### Dismiss on Green Kyllinga

### Nutsedge Tuber Viability

\*Plots treated in June. Tubers harvested in November.



*Top Left:* The 1,000 square foot area pictured is a fairway heavily infested with false green kyllinga. Photo is taken 30 days after initial application in late summer.

*Bottom Left:* Same area the following spring. The Dismiss treated soil significantly reduced germination of the rhizomes, providing long residual control.
