## THE "FLORIDA" FLY BAITER (FFB) - INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

## **PRODUCT DESCRIPTION**

The "Florida" Fly Baiter (FFB) is a patented device that attracts target pests onto a treated surface as an aid to their control.

The FFB can be used by described assembly, or flattened and attached to tree trunks, appropriate sides of buildings, etc.

The FFB can be used anywhere flies congregate or are present in numbers that could be hazardous to health. Applications in food/feed handling establishments are permitted ONLY in non-food/non-feed areas. Do not use where dead flies can contaminate food or food preparation surfaces ie. kitchens and food preparation areas.

The general placement of the FFB should be as close to the fly breeding area as possible. Where flies are breeding on ground level organic matter, the FFB should be installed at an approximate height of 1 m or 3.28 ft. If flies are breeding on organic matter in a dumpster then increase the height to approximately 1.5m or 4.92 ft. As a general guide, 1 to 1.5m or 3.28 to 4.92 ft. from the ground is ideal.

Seek areas where wind is not an issue, however for outdoor applications, this is a reality we sometimes have to contend with. Creativity with the tie-line, weighting the FFB, securing a side to a surface, attaching flat onto a wall or tree, or coupling 2 FFB's together, etc, will reduce the amount of swaying and spinning of the FFB.

IMPORTANT: Before using any EPA Registered and appropriately labeled insecticide product with the FFB, read the entire insecticide label.

## **INSTRUCTIONS TO SET UP THE "FLORIDA" FLY BAITER**

Best results occur when the FFB is installed at many interception zone locations throughout or around the structure or facility. House flies prefer warm, still sites for resting, so avoid cool or windy locations or secure the FFB so it does not sway or spin should the wind shift.

Begin installation/applications at the start of the season before fly populations have reached their peak.

- 1 Assembly: Pre-crease folds before assemby (see figure 2). Assemble each FFB by securing the plastic tabs into the corresponding slits on the edges of the FFB (see figure 3, 4, 5).
- 2 Attaching the tie-line to a structure: Secure one end of the black tie-line to a structure from which the FFB can hang down. Ensure that the structure is no more than 2.5 m/8.2 ft from the ground.
- 3 Running the tie-line through the FFB: Thread the end of the tie-line through the hole in the top of the FFB, and on through the hole in the bottom.
- 4 Adjusting the height of the FFB & attaching it on the tie-line: Adjust the height of the FFB by threading the loose end of the tie-line through the central hole on the plastic securing disc provided. Move the plastic disc up or down to adjust the recommended height of the FFB from the ground (1 to 1.5m or 3.28 to 4.92 ft.).
- 5 Securing the FFB onto the tie-line: Once the ideal height is determined, run the loose end of the tieline through the plastic securing disc a second time to create a loop, and then secure the tie-line in the slit found along the edge of the securing disc. (see figure 7, 8, 9).
- 6 Securing the tie-line to the ground: Secure the tie-line to the ground, using anything available on site or using a ground anchor.

The FFB is an ideal fly attraction surface with proven research done by the University of Florida. Using Maxforce Fly Spot Bait on FFB exterior surfaces according to label directions coincides with research conducted at the University of Florida.
