ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Avoid contamination of ornamental fish ponds. USE RESTRICTIONS

- Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial seed production, or for research purposes.
