

# MOSS MAX<sup>®</sup>

## Lawn Granules

Bonide Moss Max contains a well-known moss control ingredient (iron sulfate).

### BENEFITS:

Has enhanced coverage because of micro-sized particles.

### APPLICATION PRECAUTIONS:

Caution, product contains ferrous sulfate, which will stain sidewalks and cart paths.  
Clean hard surfaces after application.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use on plants intended for aesthetic purposes or climatic modification and being grown in ornamental gardens or parks, or on golf courses or lawns.

USE PRECAUTION: Will stain paint or concrete. Remove spillage immediately by sweeping or washing off sidewalks, driveways or other concrete or painted surfaces. Use anytime moss is a problem. Repeat if needed. Rake lawn lightly to remove leaves and dead grass. Mow lawn to expose moss and to allow fertilizer to enter soil readily. Apply with spreader at recommended rates. WATER LAWN IMMEDIATELY AFTER APPLICATION.

### NORMAL

For normal control of moss, apply at the rate of four pounds per 1,000 square feet. A 20-pound bag covers 5,000 square feet, properly applied.

### HEAVY MOSS INFESTATIONS

For heavy infestations of moss, apply at the rate of eight pounds per 1,000 square feet. A 20-pound bag covers 2,500 square feet, properly applied.
