

PT® Alpine® Pressurized Fly Bait Usage Tip – Nozzle Cleaning

Technical Information Bulletin

PT Alpine Pressurized Fly Bait is formulated to be attractive to flies and offers control for up to 30 days. It dries clear and adheres to a variety of surfaces and environments.

If on occasion the can's actuator, or nozzle, doesn't properly spray, gently move the nozzle from side to side. If the can still doesn't dispense, these five steps will clear the nozzle in about two minutes and can be performed in the field.

 Use a damp paper towel or cloth to clean the nozzle, ensuring all dirt is removed.



2. Remove the nozzle and clean around the stem of the can.



3. Place the nozzle back on the can.



4. Shake the can and turn it upside down. Press the nozzle until spray comes out.



5. Turn the can right-side up and it should spray as normal. If it doesn't, repeat the process.



If the can still won't spray properly, please return it to your distributor.

Note: **DO NOT STRIKE CAN AGAINST OBJECTS!**

Contents are under pressure and may burst, leading to injury. Cans that are treated roughly may be permanently

damaged and unable to spray properly. If there is a problem with the can spraying correctly, please follow the instructions in this technical information bulletin.
