

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Personal Precautions: Evacuate unprotected and unnecessary personnel from area of spill. Keep people away from and upwind of spill/leak. Wear personal protective equipment as described in Section 8 of this document.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

MUTAGENIC TOXICITY: No evidence of mutagenic effects during *in vivo* and *in vitro* assays.

REPRODUCTIVE/DEVELOPMENTAL TOXICITY: The only ocular effects observed in mice following mesotrione exposure were seen in the two-generation reproduction toxicity study at relatively high doses. Opaque/cloudy eyes were noted in second generation offspring at approximately 300 mg/kg/day. Additional ocular effects were observed at a dose exceeding the limit dose (cloudy eyes in parental animals; cataractous changes in offspring) in addition to decreased body weights in offspring.
