After application, always wait at least 24 hours before bathing or swimming. In multi-pet households, be sure the solution has dried before allowing pets to groom each other. Dogs may be treated indoors or outdoors. In order to help reduce the occurrence of fleas and ticks, this product is best used year round and when combined with other Vet's Best® products for pet, home and yard.

APPLICATION RATE:

Small Dogs (Under 15 lbs):	2 ml (2 droppers full)
Medium Dogs (15-40 lbs):	3.5 ml (3 1/2 droppers full)
Large Dogs (Over 40 lbs):	5 ml (5 droppers full)



DIRECTIONS FOR USE: For Dogs 12 Weeks or Older. Apply once per month. Do not exceed more than once every 2 weeks. To apply, first determine the application rate for your dog's size based on the table above. To fill the dropper applicator, squeeze the rubber top and release so it collects the formula at the desired application rate. When applying, hold your pet with one hand and use the dropper tip to part the dog's hair so the product reaches the dog's skin. Apply the liquid in an evenly distributed, straight line starting from in-between the shoulder blades at the base of the neck and down to the base of the tail (see diagram). Once the full dose has been applied allow a few minutes for the solution to be absorbed into the dog's coat before normal activities are resumed. Retain this package for future reference.

To avoid spills, screw the dropper securely on the bottle when finished.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

HUMANS: Causes moderate eye irritation. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after use. Prolonged or frequent repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. For external use only.

DOMESTIC ANIMALS: Sensitivity may occur after use of any product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lens, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. If irritation persists, contact a physician.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap and water and repeat if necessary. **INHALATION:** Remove to fresh air.

INGESTION: Immediately drink plenty of water. Do not induce vomiting. If symptoms persist, contact a physician.

Storage: Store only in original container in a cool, dry area.

Disposal: In accordance with all Federal, State and Local regulations.

If Empty: Do not reuse applicator tubes.
