CAUTION

HUMANS: Avoid direct contact. Avoid breathing spray mist. Cause moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. An application should, except every 10 to 14 days as indicated. Also, reapply each time animal is washed or exposed to heavy rain.
