APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

CARPETS: Vacuum all carpet thoroughly and dispose of bag. Apply to dry surfaces only. Apply directly on carpets where pets frequently traffic or sleep at a rate of 1 lb. per 400 square feet. Work material into fibers and mat with a broom or carpet rake. Any material visible after application must be brushed into carpet fibers or removed. Wait 5-7 days before vacuuming. Allow 3-5 weeks for maximum flea control. Reapply as necessary. Note: If high adult flea population makes it desirable, apply a pesticide designed to kill adult fleas before or in conjunction with this product.
